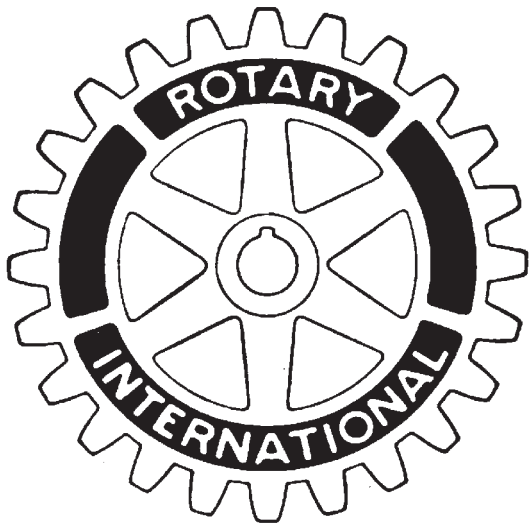

Next Week's Speaker...

Michael Blown founded Old Friends, a retirement farm for Thoroughbreds, in 2003 after it became known that Ferdinand, 1986 Kentucky Derby winner and 1987 Horse of the Year, had been "disposed of" in a Japanese slaughterhouse.



For two decades he was movie critic and arts writer for the Boston Globe, and prior to that he taught film at Emerson College and Boston University. Blown mucked out stalls and hot-walked horses in the early morning, before reporting for his newspaper job. After retiring from the Globe he moved to Kentucky to work as Operations Director for the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation. Two years later he started Old Friends, the only Thoroughbred retirement or rescue facility that accepts stallions. Old Friends cares for over 100 Thoroughbreds, including stallions whose racing and breeding careers have ended. Old Friends also has some deserving mares and geldings, among them Popcorn Deelites, who played Seabiscuit in the movie. Old Friends, a non-profit facility, is open to the public every day for tours.
