*Next Week's Speaker...*

Conrad Trow began shoeing in 1996 at the Kentucky Horseshoeing School in Mt. Eden, Kentucky. After completing the 12-week course, he returned to his native South Africa and served an apprenticeship with Andrew Timm in the Natal Midlands, where he worked on all types of sport horses. After completing his apprenticeship in 1999, he returned to the United States and accepted a position as instructor at the Kentucky Horseshoeing School under the guidance of Mitch Taylor, CJF. During the two years he worked for Mitch, he also worked part-time, establishing his shoeing business in the Louisville area. Conrad spent countless hours practicing for and competing in horse-shoeing competitions across the country. He quickly worked through the divisions. In 2000, he obtained both his Certified Farrier (CF) and Certified Journeyman Farrier (CJF) designations from the American Farrier's Association.

"I was very fortunate to be able to spend a lot of time working with Craig Trnka, CJF," said Conrad. Craig and Conrad were able to win the draft horse class at the AFA's National Convention four consecutive years. In 2007, with the guidance of Craig, Mitch and

many other horseshoers across the country, Conrad earned the right to be on the American Farriers Team. With co-members Bill Poor CJF, Billy Reed CJF, Travis Koons CJF, and Todd Walker CJF, they were able to win the draft horse shoeing class at the 2007 World Championships at the Calgary S, Alberta, Canada. Conrad's farrier business focuses on eventers, dressage, jumpers and a few hunter horses. He has an apprentice working with him on a daily basis. He also competes on a regular basis at events sponsored by the World Championship Blacksmiths, as well as a few local events. Conrad and his wife Jennifer reside in Shelbyville.
