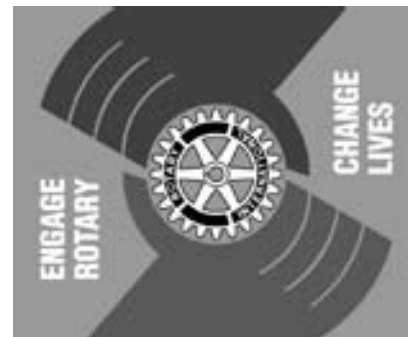

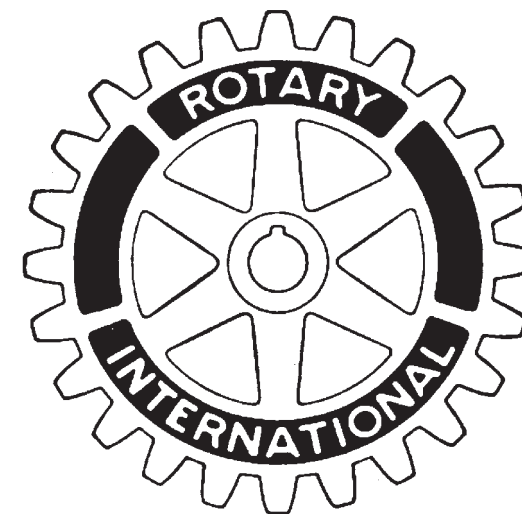
Board Action July 15, 2013
