My name is **Sam Marcus**, and I'm a life-long resident of Frankfort. My wife, Diane Tilley Marcus and I have been married for 28 years. Our only 'children' are furry ones, i.e. 3 cats. I attended public school in Frankfort from 3rd grade (when my dad ran for the school board!) until high school – one year at Frankfort High, then transferring to Sayre School and graduating from there.
