*Next Week's Speaker...*

Sarah Milligan, a native Oklahoman, holds an M.A. in Folk Studies from Western Kentucky University and a B. A. in English and German from Oklahoma City University. Since 2007, Milligan has been the oral history administrator for the Kentucky Historical Society, which includes providing staff support to the Kentucky Oral History Commission. Her current responsibilities consist of managing the KOHC granting programs, leading oral history workshops statewide, as well as offering technical assistance to Kentucky oral history collection holders. Milligan also oversees the more than 9,000 oral history interviews in the KOHC archives at the Society. In 2012, she became part of the Library of Congress Digital Preservation Outreach Trainer Network. Before joining the KOHC, Milligan worked as a folklife specialist for the Kentucky Folklife Program, which included managing the growing network of Kentucky Community Scholars.

**Rotary approves \$500,000 emergency grant for Somalia**

Rotary has approved a \$500,000 Rapid Response grant to the World Health Organization (WHO) to address a recent polio outbreak in Somalia. The outbreak occurred in the Banadir region of Somalia, where a large number of children had not been vaccinated against polio due to inaccessibility.

As of 14 August, 110 cases of wild poliovirus have been reported in the Horn of Africa—100 cases in Somalia and 10 in Kenya. This is the first outbreak in Somalia since 2007 and in Kenya since 2011.

The Rotary grant will cover operational costs, including human resources, training, and transportation of health workers, aimed at immunizing children under 10 in all accessible areas of Somalia in August.

To date, five vaccination campaigns have been held in Somalia, three in Kenya, two each in Ethiopia and Yemen, and one in Djibouti. Additional campaigns are planned through the end of the year.
