Sheriff Keith Cain is a veteran of the USMC, including a tour of duty in South Viet Nam. He has served continuously with the Daviess County Sheriff's Office since 1974. His past duties include Patrol, Investigations, Narcotics, and Chief Deputy. He was elected Sheriff in 1999 and is currently serving in his 4th term. Sheriff Cain is an adjunct faculty member of the Owensboro Community and Technical College and is a KLEC certified law enforcement instructor. He also serves as the chair of that entity (KLEC), a body responsible for all police training in Kentucky.
