*Next Week's Speaker...*

**Christopher Fuchs** of Stamping Ground from August, 2011-July, 2012 was a Rotary Youth Exchange student from Rotary District 6740 East Kentucky to Rotary District 2630 in Gifu and Mie Prefectures, Japan. Chris, an Eagle Scout from Boy Scout Troop 177 of the First Christian Church in



Georgetown, went to Japan as a 16-year-old high school student and wrote about his experiences in a blog titled "An Eagle in Japan." The blog, located at [aneagleinjapan.blogspot.com](http://aneagleinjapan.blogspot.com), has over 125 entries and 10,500 page views. Chris will present his observations and experiences as a Rotary goodwill ambassador to Japan as chronicled therein from visiting Hiroshima in August, 2011 to making over 25 speeches to various groups over the course of the year – all in Japanese.

While in Japan, Chris was hosted by the Gifu Nagaragawa Rotary Club. He lived in Gifu-shi near Nagoya and attended Gifu Commercial and Business High School. He was enrolled

in the international studies section and was a member of the school's judo club and judo team. He stayed with six families in the surrounding environs, and travelled over 3,000 miles to and from school by bicycle.

Chris is currently a senior at Scott County High School and the Elkhorn Crossing School where he is a member of the Pre-Engineering Village. He is active in competitive robotics and in April competed at the 2013 Vex Robotics World Championships in Anaheim, California. He was the winner of the UK Engineering Minds on Innovation award at the STLP state championships last spring. He has been awarded eight medals at the state Science Olympiad since 2008.

Chris is the son of Rotarian Greg Fuchs and Lana Grandon. A 2013 Governor's Scholar, Chris plans on attending either Western Kentucky University or Murray State University next fall to pursue a career in engineering. He also wishes to first return to Japan and work as an English language teacher.
