Next Week's Speaker...

Donald C. "Don" Butler, a retired educator and public servant has lived in Bowling Green since 1973. He retired as Executive Director of Community Action of Southern Kentucky after leading the organization for twenty years. His prior experiences include: Associate Professor of Education at Western Kentucky University; and, the development of Community Education Programs in Bowling Green-Warren County and in Frankfort-Franklin County Kentucky, while serving as Executive Director of both programs.

A native of May's Lick (Mason County) Kentucky, one of seven children from a farming family, Don enlisted in the United States Marine Corps upon graduation from high school, served in Vietnam and was Honorably Discharged with the rank of Sergeant. After his military service he enrolled at Morehead State University, attended school on the G.I. Bill and worked his way through college earning his Bachelor of Arts, With High Distinction, and his Master of Arts while serving as a Graduate Research Assistant with the MSU Appalachian Adult Education Center. After completing his

graduate work at Morehead State, he received a C.S. Mott Foundation Fellowship from the National Center for Community Education in Flint, MI and earned his Ph. D. from Michigan State University.

Don remains active in numerous organizations and groups. He is a member of the American Legion Post 23, a Life-Member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1298, and volunteers his time and resources to support and advocate for veterans, active duty military men and women and their families. He actively supports the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Program and is in his 15th year as Chairman of the Governor's Council for Community Education, where he and Council members advocate for education policy in the Commonwealth.

He has been recognized for his leadership and service by many groups. In 2006 he received the Jefferson Award for Public Service from the Bowling Green Daily News and WBKO-TV, and in Washington D. C. from the American Institute for Public Service. That same year he received the Tim Lee Carter Distinguished Service Award from the Area Development District. In 2001 he received the Professional Service Award from the National Community Education Association.

Don and his wife Becky are the proud parents of five adult, married children and have been further blessed with eleven grandchildren.
