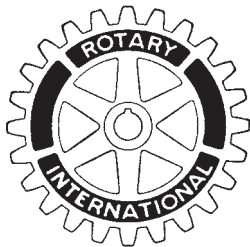

* Approved the November 18, 2013 board minutes. John Avent made the motion, seconded by Gordon Saks.

* Acknowledged with regrets resignations from Phil Huddleston and Joe Teasley.

* Approved leave-of-absences for Bhikhu Chauban from 12/10/13 to 1/6/14, Teresa Hockensmith from 1/8/14 to 1/28/14, Jim Terrell from 11/12/13 to 12/16/13, and Donna Hecker from 12/4/13 to 12/25/13. Joyce Honaker made the motion, seconded by Dan Egbers.

* Discussed the attendance report and which letters should be sent out for the Rotarians past due on their dues and those with low attendances. No motions made.

* Approved the November 2013 Financial report as presented by John Avent. Dan Egbers made the motion, seconded by Kristin Cantrell.

* John Avent reported that the club was still holding money's collected for UNICEF because he was waiting on the Interact's check. President Dave will contact Sherrill Smith.
