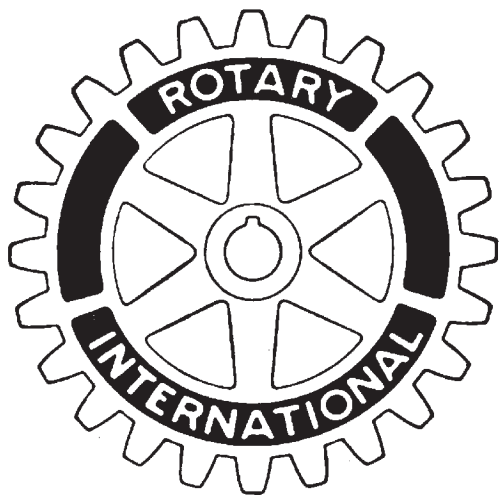

Ms. Samuella Daum – or just “Sam” as she is often called – has been involved with the Council on Family Abuse in one way or another since 2008. She was raised not too far away in the neighboring state of Tennessee and, prior to moving to Kentucky, spent sev-



eral years in Central Florida. In 2006, Samuella moved to Frankfort and has been residing here ever since. Ms. Daum is a graduate of The University of Memphis and holds a Bachelor's degree in Psychosocial Development. Her professional experience is diverse and includes professional writing, real estate, property management, retail management and commercial cleaning. Samuella's education and work experience play an important role in her qualifications as the Director, but it's her relevant life experiences that make her uniquely qualified to lead and direct the Council toward continued growth and awareness.

For nearly 14 years, Ms. Daum was a victim of domestic violence and is all too familiar with the silence by which victims are imprisoned and the ultimate physical, emotional, and mental repercussions that abuse causes. Additionally, Ms. Daum had the unfortunate experience of being homeless for a few challenging months. The combination of these two experiences, along with her professional background, has enabled Samuella to fully grasp the devastation that domestic violence victims experience.

Ms. Daum is not shy about the subject of domestic violence, victims, or abusers. She is dedicated to exposing the truth about violent abusers, the cycle of abuse, and the power and control abusers work so diligently to obtain. She has a heart for victims, empathizing with them and doing whatever she can to help them recover and undo the painful emotional, mental and physical state in which they've silently suffered. Samuella is determined to continue bringing awareness to the citizens of Franklin County regarding the reality of domestic violence and how it impacts families, children, relationships, and the community as a whole.

Emergency funds aim to quell polio outbreak in Syria, Middle East

Rotary will provide a \$500,000 emergency response grant to support efforts to stem the recent polio outbreak in Syria. The funds are the first to the World Health Organization in direct support of a Global Polio Eradication Initiative plan to conduct large-scale immunization campaigns in the Middle East.

“It is imperative that we stop this outbreak quickly to protect children in Syria and throughout the region,” says Rotary's International PolioPlus Committee Chair Robert S. Scott. “Rotary and our partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative are working together with local health authorities to activate the outbreak response.”

He noted that the cases in Syria appear to be imported from Pakistan, one of three countries where the wild poliovirus remains endemic. “These and other recent polio cases in previously polio-free countries serve as stark reminders that as long as polio still exists anywhere in the world, all unimmunized children everywhere remain at risk,” says Scott.

Today, seven countries across the region rolled out vaccination campaigns aiming to reach 22 million children. These campaigns are planned to be repeated over the next six months to protect children in the region from the polio outbreak.
