### Next Week's Speaker

**Dr. Robert D. Hilgers, MD MA CAE** is President and CEO of the Women's Global Cancer Alliance (WGCA). The WGCA works to advance women's health, addressing particularly those in need of cancer care in developing countries. 80% of cancers in women occur in developing countries where only 5% of resources are available for care.



Dr. Hilgers is a board certified Gynecologic Oncologist and Professor Emeritus at the University of Louisville School of Medicine. He has been in leadership positions most of his life, serving close to 30 years in various positions as Professor of Gynecologic Oncology, Division Chief and Department Chairman. He trained in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Mayo Clinic (Rochester, Minnesota) and in Gynecologic Oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York City.

His current work is focused on the need to prevent cancer of the cervix in the 90%

of women who have no access to treatment in Haiti. Haiti has the highest incidence of cervical cancer in the world. He has been instrumental in initiating a cervical cancer prevention clinic in Gros Mon ("grow maan") and is currently working to establish a cervical cancer prevention clinic and training center in Gonaives ("go-naive"). In addition, he is working with the Haitian Ministry of Health to build a National Cancer Treatment Center and establishing a National Cancer Registry. He served with a medical disaster relief team two weeks after the earthquake of January 12, 2010.
