Next Week's Program...

In November 2011, voters elected **Jack Conway** to a second term as Kentucky's 49th Attorney General. Jack is committed to working with local leaders and law-enforcement officers to make Kentucky a safer place to live, work, and raise a family. As Attorney General, Jack has followed through on his commitment to vigorously prosecute child



predators and crack down on Internet crimes. In June 2008, Jack created a Cybercrimes Unit to investigate online solicitations of minors, scams and identity theft. The Cybercrimes Unit has launched more than 250 child pornography investigations and seized more than nearly 300,000 images and videos. Attorney General Conway also visits schools in every corner of the Commonwealth to educate students, teachers and parents about how to safely use social-networking sites. During the 2009 legislative session, Conway crafted and helped pass comprehensive cybersafety legislation which banned registered sex offenders from using social-networking sites that are frequented by

minors and created the crimes of cyberstalking and phishing. In December 2012, General Conway received the Leadership Award from The Century Council for his efforts to combat drunk driving and underage drinking.

Jack is a graduate of St. Xavier High School in Louisville, KY. He holds an undergraduate degree in public policy from Duke University. While in college, he studied at Cambridge University in England. He graduated with honors from the National Law Center at George Washington University. Jack is married to Elizabeth Davenport Conway. He and Elizabeth are the proud parents of two daughters, Eva and Alex.

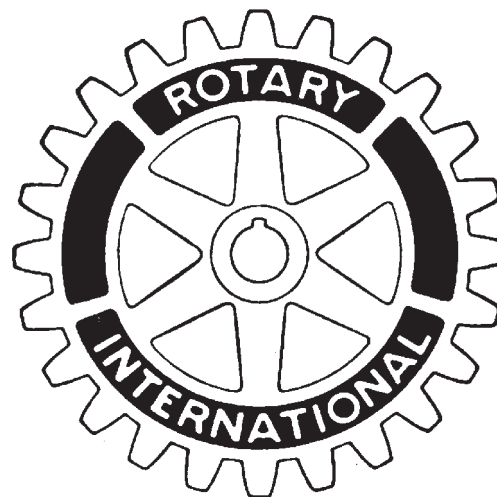
Board Action March 17, 2014
