Next Week's Program

A.B. "Ben" Chandler III carries one of the most recognizable names in the history



of Kentucky. His grandfather served as a two-term Governor of the Commonwealth, U.S. Senator, and Commissioner of major league baseball. Ben followed his grandfather in service. He was born in Versailles, graduated from Woodford County High University of Kentucky with

School and the University of Kentucky with degrees in history and law. He also studied at the University of London and Trinity College, and completed an internship with the British Parliament. After practicing law, he was elected Kentucky State Auditor in 1991 and served two terms as Kentucky's Attorney General from 1995-2003. As State Auditor he undertook and completed audits of every elected office holder in Kentucky. As Attorney General he won passage of Kentucky's "No Call" law to protect seniors from telemarketers, successfully fought to strengthen Kentucky's "Megan's Law," secured billions for Kentucky farmers and farm communities through the tobacco Master Settlement Agreement. He was the Democratic nominee for Governor in 2003. In 2004 he was elected to fill an unexpired term in the U.S. House of Representatives and re-elected four times. His committee assignments included Foreign Affairs, Agriculture, Intelligence, Homeland Security, Transportation, and Ethics. He was a member of the Blue Dog Coalition, Chair of the British American Parliamentary Group, member of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly, and delegate to over 60 countries. In 2013 he became Executive Director of the Kentucky Humanities Council. He is a resident of Versailles.
