**Renee Michelle Shaw** is producer, writer and host at KET, and a native of Portland, Tennessee. She graduated from Western Kentucky University in 1994 with baccalaureate degrees in Broadcast Journalism and Government, and a Masters of Arts in Corporate Communications in 1996. In 1997, she began her career at KET as a reporter and associate producer. In the fall of 2005, she launched the first statewide minority affairs program on KET Connections with Renee Shaw. As one of KET's public affairs program producers, Renee is producer/managing editor and host of KET's legislative coverage, host of the series Health 360 that examines a health issue from three perspectives in 60 minutes; co-hosts election night coverage, produced KET's longest running public affairs programs "Comment on Kentucky" for more than a decade, and produces numerous other issue-centered programs at KET.

Active in several community/professional organizations, Renee is a 2007 graduate and member of Leadership Kentucky; 1st Vice President of the executive committee of the

Kentucky Historical Society; a board member of the Lexington Bluegrass Area Minority Business Expo; a steering committee member of the University of Kentucky Institute for Rural Journalism and Community Issues; and a member and program chair of the Frankfort-Lexington Chapter of The Links, Incorporated. Renee travels across the state moderating public issues forums and speaking about diversity, media, public policy and state legislative matters.
