The club will have a Club Assembly as well as taking a vote on the proposed Amendments to the Club By-Laws, to-wit:

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS  
TO THE BY-LAWS**

**Article 3 Election of Directors and Officers**

Section 1 - Each September, the President shall convene a nominating committee consisting of the five most immediate past presidents of the Club, one member with less than 5 years of membership and one member with more than 10 years membership, both of whom shall be appointed by the President. The former President who served the club in the capacity 5 years prior to the convening of the committee shall serve as Chair of the Nominating Committee. The President and President-elect shall be ex-officio members of the Nominating Committee. If an immediate past president is unable to serve, the president shall fill the vacancy, selecting another past president if possible.

Section 2 - During the first regular meeting in December, the Nominating Committee shall present nominees for the offices of presi-

dent, president-elect, president nominee, secretary/treasurer, sergeant-at-arms, Director of Club Service, Director of International Service, Director of Vocational Service, Director of Community Service, Director of Youth Services, Director of Membership and Director of Public Relations. No member of the Nominating Committee, except the President and President-elect, shall be eligible to serve on the incoming Board. Nominations shall also be accepted from the floor.
