Richard Young is the Executive Director of the North Limestone Community Development Corporation, a Lexington non-profit that was founded in 2013. NoLi's mission is to work on the Liveability of the North Limestone Corridor through projects such as the LuigArt Makers' Spaces, which will build affordable houses for artists and other entrepreneurs in which to live and work.



A native Lexingtonian and a classically-trained double bassist, Richard is a graduate of the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, and has worked with numerous arts organizations in an administrative or consulting role, including LexArts, the Downtown Arts Center, Central Kentucky Youth Orchestras, and many more. In addition to his work with NoLi CDC, Richard teaches double bass privately, performs with various ensembles in the region, and is the director of the annual Chamber Music Festival of Lexington.

Under Richard's leadership, NoLi has been involved in a number of programs including The Night Market, a Vibrancy Map, the Northside Common Market, and the study of environmental and sustainability issues within its neighborhoods.

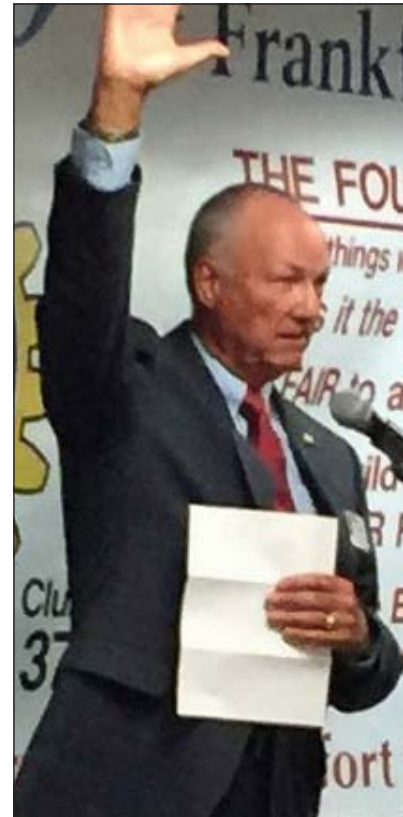
Reminders
