Congressman Andy Barr first took the oath of office as the U.S. Representative



Kentucky's Sixth for Congressional District on Jan. 3, 2013 and serves on the Committee on Financial Services and as co-chair of the bipartisan Congressional Horse Caucus. He supports policies that restore government accountability, includ-

ing introducing the Live by the Laws you Write Act, which would ensure Members of Congress do not receive any special treatment, and supports "No Budget, No Pay" provisions that would require Congress do its job in order to get paid. He also co-authored the bipartisan Saving Lives, Saving Costs act to improve health care and lower costs.

Congressman Barr has initiated several constituent coalitions focused on finding solutions that will help Kentucky's Veterans and signature industries. He holds public events in each county he represents, meeting directly with constituents, maintaining monthly staff office hours in every county, and publishes actively

on social media and in his weekly eNewsletter. He and his wife Carol are the parents of Eleanor and Mary Clay, and are members of the Good Shepherd Episcopal Church. Andy has served on the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Isaac Murphy Memorial Art Garden and Prevent Child Abuse Kentucky.

Business of the Year Award

This year the Rotary sponsored "Business of the Year Award" will be named Frank Sower Business of the Year. Frank Sower was a fellow Rotarian for 65 years. He owned Sower Hardware and Sower Office Equipment from 1937 to 1983. He was the first president of the new Frankfort/Franklin Co. Chamber of Commerce, was president of The Kentucky Retail Hardware Association, received the first President's award from the Chamber of Commerce, was the only person to serve two different governors as President of the Kentucky Historical Society, was president of the Frankfort Rotary Club, and also was an undefeated YMCA grade school basketball coach in regular season and tournament play for three years.
