Monthly Make-Up Meeting

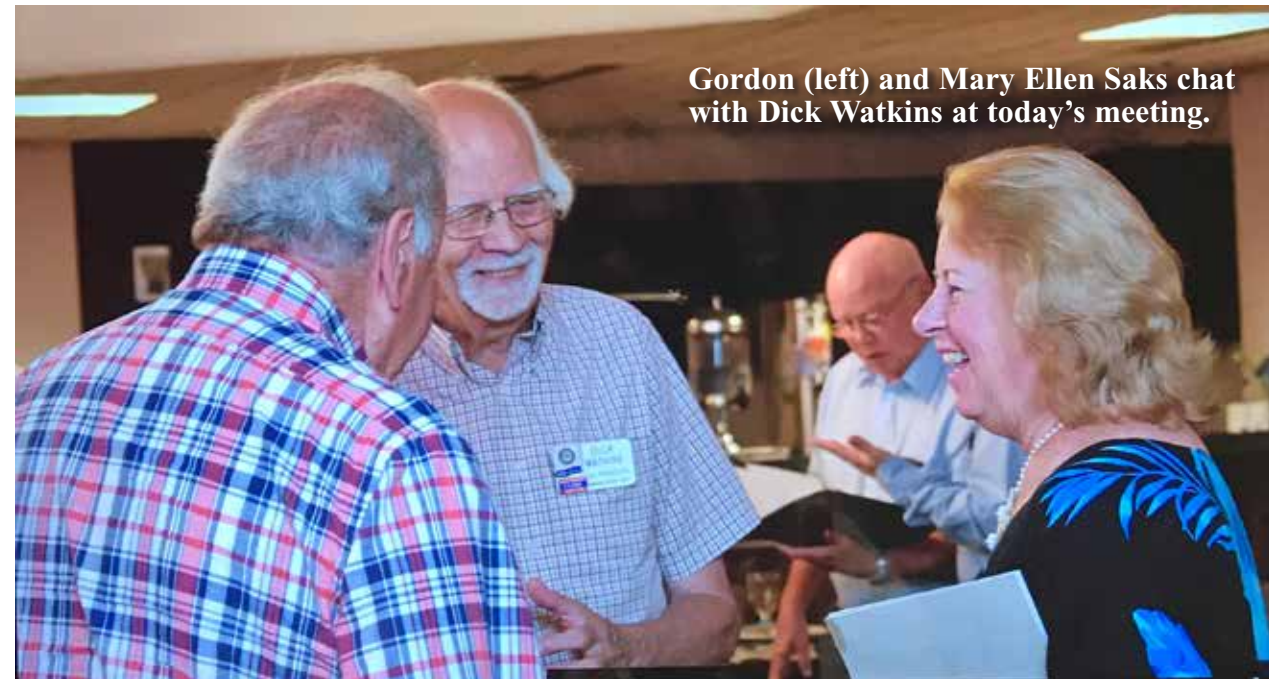
