The mission of the Soup Kitchen is to provide at least one nutritious meal seven days of each week by way of a food service program to address the immediate suffering of the low income and disadvantaged individuals and families.

Andrew is also heavily involved with the Boy Scouts of America. He is an Assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 215 out of Georgetown, where his two sons are actively involved with the Troop. Andrew is the Lodge Chaplain of Hiram Lodge #4 F&AM in Frankfort, and a member of Scottish Rite Consistory in Lexington. He has been married to Lynn Baker since 1994, and together they have two teenage sons, Thomas and Tyler. They live in South Frankfort.
