Board Action Dec. 21, 2015

The Frankfort Rotary Club Board met on Monday, December 21, 2015 at the Red Cross Building. Present were Dan Egbers, Gordon and Mary Ellen Saks, Sallie Clay Lanham, Shirley Elkin, John Avent, Paula Rutledge, Kristin Cantrell, Chuck Dickinson, Donna Hecker, and Joyce Honaker.

John Avent presented the Treasurer's report, which the Board accepted on motion of Kristen Cantrell, seconded by Sallie Clay Lanham. President Dan communicated a request from Pat Badgett for a leave of absence from December 7 to January 1. The leave was approved on motion of Kristin Cantrell seconded by John

Avent. President Dan and John Avent noted that the Club has committed to giving \$2,000 to Polio Plus, but that there is no appropriation in the budget for that. Therefore, they proposed a \$20 assessment per member for that purpose. The assessment would be in the next dues statement and would not be optional. The assessment would be tax deductible. The Board approved the assessment on motion by Chuck Dickinson seconded by John Avent.

Under Directors' reports, Kristin Cantrell, Director of Club Service, reported that 12 Salvation Army Angels' gift requests were filled by the Club and individual members. She noted the hot meal provided for the Club's Christmas party. Dan Egbers reported for Paula Rarden that the Hotel will try to provide the Club with one hot meal per month. Gordon Saks reported for Community Service that he had met with Jennifer Zingg to discuss Phase 2 of the Ward Oates children's mural project which will include expansion of the mural, providing two benches and planting a tree. The cost will be \$4,000 of which \$2,500 is on hand. The Club will need to have a fundraiser for the remaining \$1,500. We also need to get members involved in supporting the children as they do the painting.

President Dan reported that Gordon Saks had suggested naming one of the President's end-of-year awards for Carol Palmore. He proposed to name the Rotarian of the Year Award for Carol. The proposal was approved on motion by Sallie Clay Lanham seconded by Chuck Dickinson.

Continuing with Directors' reports, Shirley Elkin reported that, at her request, several members are helping, or are being sought to help, with the speech contests, scholarships, RYLA, and the Interact Club. She is seeking to involve newer members in those projects. Donna Hecker reported that one new members is ready to be inducted. She discussed several prospective new members. President Dan reported that Teresa Hockensmith, Director of

Public Relations, has been submitting articles and pictures to the District 6710 Spectrum newsletter on a regular basis. Director of Vocational Service Sallie Clay Lanham reported that she now has 12 volunteers mentoring Westridge first graders in reading and spelling, but could use more. She received a nice note from the school, which she will read to the Club on Dec. 23. Joyce Honaker reported on an effort to have members who want 2015 tax credit for Rotary Foundation contributions to write a check to the Foundation and give it to her or Bob Bullock no later than the Dec. 23 meeting so they can fill out a donation report and have it postmarked no later than Dec. 31.

President Dan noted that the Dec. 30 meeting will be a Club Assembly. Because January 18 is Martin Luther King Day, the Board voted to have the January Board meeting on the 25th, on motion by John Avent seconded by Gordon Sax. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
