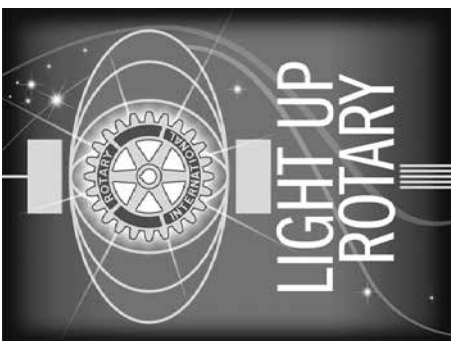

\* Approved the minutes of the December 26, 2016 board meeting. Kristin Cantrell made the motion, second by John Avent.

\* Acknowledged with regrets resignation of fellow Rotarian Scott McCoun.

\* Approved leave-of-absences for the following: Barry Holder 2/17/17-4/15/17, Teresa Hockensmith 1/1/17-2/3/17 and Tom Utterback 12/1/17-4/15/17. Kristin Cantrell made the motion, second by Donna Hecker.

\* Approved the Financial report for December 2016 with revisions made by John Avent. Fred Deaton made the motion, second by Kristin Cantrell.
