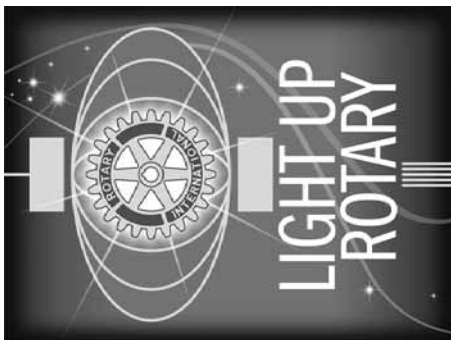

Teena Halbig graduated in 1972 from U of L



with a B.S. and Certificate in Medical Technology. She worked about 20 years in the medical field, then became a successful small business president and CEO. In 2005, Teena began leadership with League of Women Voters of Louisville as president, then

served as their state president for three years. Teena served two years (beginning in 2007) on the state board of the Kentucky Division of the United Nations Association of the United States of America became state President January 2009 - to present.

When the "Cities for CEDAW" (CEDAW = Convention on the Elimination of all forms of Discrimination Against Women) initiative was born from the 58th UN Commission on the Status of Women in 2014, Teena, as UNA-USA KY President, became active and worked in a coalition in Louisville.

Gov. Beshear appointed Teena to the state Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easements (PACE) in 2008 and 2010.

Commissioner James B. Comer gave her an award as an Honorary Agriculture Commissioner. In 2012 she was named Better World Champion by the Better World Campaign Fund, a sister organization to the UNA-USA. She has also had the UN Foundation Shot@ Life training. In 2015, she began serving on the Louisville Metro Human Trafficking Task Force and is helping with their By-laws revisions. Teena retired in January of 2013 but remains an active civic volunteer.
