He received his BS in Biology from the University of Alabama in Birmingham, his MS from Samford University and his PhD in Aquaculture from Mississippi State University. He has been with KSU since 1987. He was named a KSU Distinguished Professor in 2014. He has authored or co-authored over 120 articles in refereed scientific journals as well as eleven book chapters and served as editor on two books. He has served as President of both the US Aquaculture Society and the World Aquaculture Society.
