Chef Ouita Michel and her husband Chris opened the Holly Hill Inn in 2001. Born in Wyoming, she moved with her family to Lexington, and grew up in neighborhoods around UK, where her father was on the medical school faculty.



Ouita's food-loving family and extensive travels inspired an interest in cooking that led her to

the Culinary Institute of America after her graduation from UK. It was at the CIA that she met husband Chris, a native of Long Island. The couple relocated to Lexington and began working in several area restaurants, including Dudley's and Emmett's.

Today they own what has come to be known as Chef Ouita's Family of Restaurants, which includes the Holly Hill Inn, Wallace Station, Glenn's Creek Café at the Woodford Reserve Distillery, Midway School Bakery, Windy Corner Market & Café, and Smithtown Seafood.

A guiding principle of Ouita's restaurant family is community involvement and investment in our Kentucky agricultural economy. Her restaurants have spent more than \$2 million on Kentucky Proud foods over the last 10 years. Ouita is active in her church, First Christian Midway; is a member of the Prichard Committee for Academic Excellence; and serves on the board of FoodChain, a non-profit urban food incubator in Lexington. She and her husband Chris and daughter Willa live in a 200-year-old log cabin adjacent to the Holly Hill Inn on Winter Street in Midway.
