Lowell Reese, a native of Pike County, graduated from Berea College in 1963 with a B.A. degree in history. After serving in Vietnam as an Army officer in the infantry, he was vice president of governmental affairs for the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce. During the 1980s he was president and CEO of the South Carolina Chamber of Commerce and also the Arizona Chamber of Commerce. In 1990 he founded Kentucky Roll Call, a publishing company in Frankfort, Ky., which specializes in public affairs reporting.



His current publications include Kentucky Roll Call, an insiders' newsletter on Kentucky's public finances, politics and elections; The Kentucky Atlas, a commercial reference of towns and places in Kentucky; Who's What in Kentucky Government, a pictorial directory of state legislators; Second Circle, a pictorial directory of lobbyists; and Kentucky OSHA Journal, a newsletter on safety and health in the workplace. He formerly owned and pub-

lished The Kentucky Gazette, the namesake of Kentucky's first newspaper, which he revived in 1995. Lowell and his wife Carol live in Frankfort.

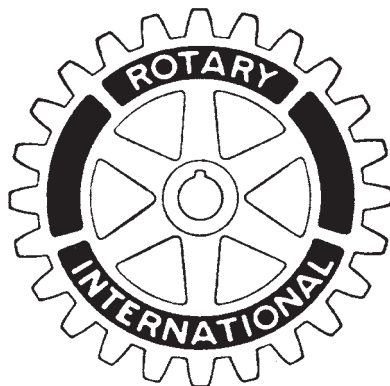

 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
