Next Week's Program...

Ernest P. Fowler was born in Harlan County in the heart of coal country. In 1959, after graduating from high school at Harlan, Mr. Fowler joined the United States Marine Corps. He served four years at various bases in the U. S., finishing his tour at Da Nang, Vietnam. After being honorably discharged, Mr. Fowler returned to Harlan and enrolled in Southeast Community College in Cumberland, KY. He graduated from UK in 1963 with a BS in psychology. He was recruited by the state Department of Personnel as an Examinations Technician in the Recruitment, and Examinations Division in the early years of the Merit System. Later Mr. Fowler returned to UK and earned a Ed. D. degrees in Educational Psychology. After completing his academic career in 1978, Fowler worked with the Deferred Compensation Program and the state's office automation/computer initiative. Mr. Fowler finished up his government career as the Deputy Secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet.



In 1989, Mr. Fowler embarked on a new career as an entrepreneur. With his wife Jan as a key partner, they owned and operated a very successful retail gift business along with several other ventures. In 1995, Mr. Fowler began his current business, the Candleberry Company, which sells scented candles and other products to over 1200 retail stores, primarily in the eastern half of the United States.
