Next week's program will be the installation of the new Rotary officers.



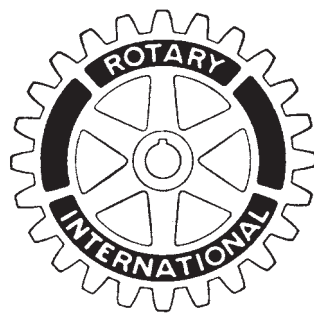
