Frankfort Sister Cities**

On March 5, Frankfort officially became a Sister City with Shimamoto-cho, Osaka Prefecture, Japan. The signing ceremony was the culmination of two years' work between representatives of both communities.



The event took place during a World Trade Center Kentucky visit to Japan, which included Cabinet for Economic Development Secretary Terry Gill and Commissioner Mandy Lambert, as well as regional economic development representatives and other business leaders. The group was headed by WTC-KY President Ed Webb. The ceremony included videos by Governor Bevin and Mayor May of Frankfort. Bill Marshall, chairman of Frankfort Sister Cities, represented Frankfort for the ceremony.

Shimamoto is the home of Suntory's Yamazaki Distillery and Frankfort has a Beam Suntory bottling plant. Lexington already has a horse connection with their Sister City of

Shinhidaka, and now Kentucky's other signature industry of whiskey is represented in Japan by the Frankfort-Shimamoto connection.
