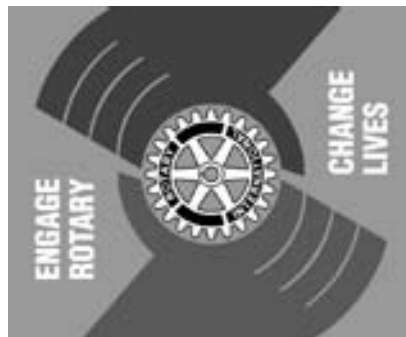

Next Week's Program...

Randy Thomas is currently serving in his second term as President of the Bluegrass Cycling Club (BCC). The BCC is a membership organization whose purposes include: encouraging bicycling for health, recreation and transportation; promotion of bicycle safety; and improving bicycle facilities. The BCC has more than 800 paid members in the Bluegrass Region. Randy has served as the Event Director for the Horseys Hundred, the club's signature event drawing more than 2,000 cyclists to Central Kentucky each Memorial weekend. Randy also started the Bluegrass Bike Partner program in Midway, KY now a project of the BCC with Partners located throughout Kentucky. The Bluegrass Bike Partner project was created to promote bicycling and establish a safe, supportive and welcoming relationship between cyclists, businesses, churches, public agencies, public and private organizations and private individuals.



In January of 2013 Randy was appointed to the Kentucky Bicycle and Bikeway Commission by Governor Steven Beshear. The Kentucky

Bicycle and Bikeway Commission (KBBC) was formed by the Kentucky legislature in 1992. The Commission is tasked to: 1) represent the interests of bicyclists in advising the Secretary of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet on all matters pertaining to the use, extent, and location of bicycles and bikeways; 2) assist the bicycle and bikeway program in the exercise of its duties within the Cabinet, and 3) promote the best interests of the bicycling public, within the context of the total transportation system, to governing officials and the public at large.

Randy and his wife Pam are avid cyclists and live in Midway, KY.
