Sallie Clay Lanham will be speaking on the Womens' Rights Movement. An award-winning artist and teacher, Sallie is a resident of Frankfort. Since graduation from the Art Academy of Cincinnati, she has been an elementary art educator, Kentucky State University art instructor and a Kentucky Arts Council Roster Artist. Sallie has also taught at the Cincinnati Art Museum children's classes, Capital Day School, Good Shepherd School, The Kings Center, and private children and adult classes. She received a fellowship to the Virginia Center for the Creative Arts sponsored by the Kentucky Foundation for Women. She was selected as a Kentucky Arts Council Roster Artist, the Frankfort Area Chamber of Commerce Artist of the year 2008 and People's Choice Award as Frankfort's Best Artist/Author 2011 for the book "Portrait of Early Families – Frankfort Area before 1860." Professional work experience includes graphic designer and art director with work reproduced in local and national publications. Her work has been exhibited in many juried shows.
