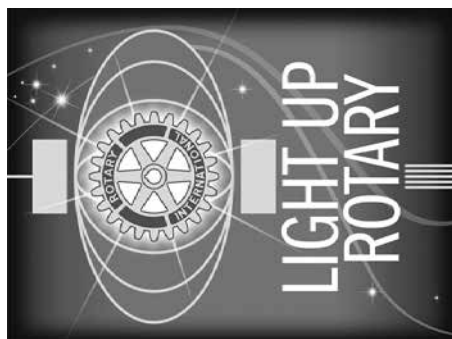

Bill Crist is a dairy farmer in Metcalfe County. Bill will discuss how the dairy industry has changed and how milk is produced today. He is in a partnership with his son where they milk 600 cows three times a day. They produce 6,000 gallons of milk a day that is utilized primarily as fluid milk. Corn silage, hay, grain, vitamins and minerals are blended into what is called a total mixed ration, providing cows with a balanced feed mix every day. Great care is taken to maintain healthy cows and produce a safe, wholesome and nutritious product.
