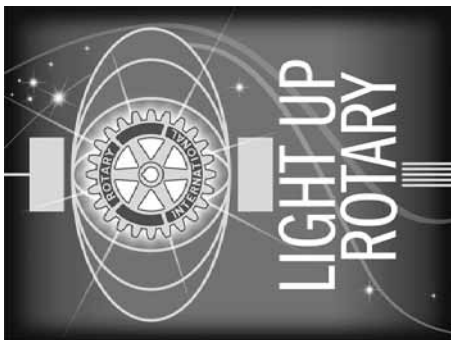

Next Week's Program...

Next week's speaker is Frank E. Henson, who is:

- A Member of the Board of Directors of Cincy Red Bike, Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky's Bike Share System;

- President of Queen City Bike, Greater Cincinnati's only member-based bicycle advocacy organization. QCB works to make streets safer for cycling and to bring our unique and diverse cycling community together from the grassroots up;



- Chair of Tri-State Trails, a coalition of trail advocates,

a physical network of trails, with a vision to connect people and places via a regional trails network that promotes vibrant communities through equitable access to active transportation and outdoor recreation;

- Member - Cincinnati Connects, which is a coalition of bicycle groups that has developed a plan for an ambitious 42-mile urban trail loop throughout the city of Cincinnati which would connect 32 city neighborhoods and create a new, alternative transportation system; and

- League of American Bicyclists Master League Certified Instructor (LCI), specializing in urban bicycling. LCIs are certified to teach the Smart Cycling classes to children as well as adults. The goal is to help people feel more secure about getting on a bike, to create a mindset that bikes are treated as a vehicle, and to ensure that people on bikes know how to ride safely and legally.

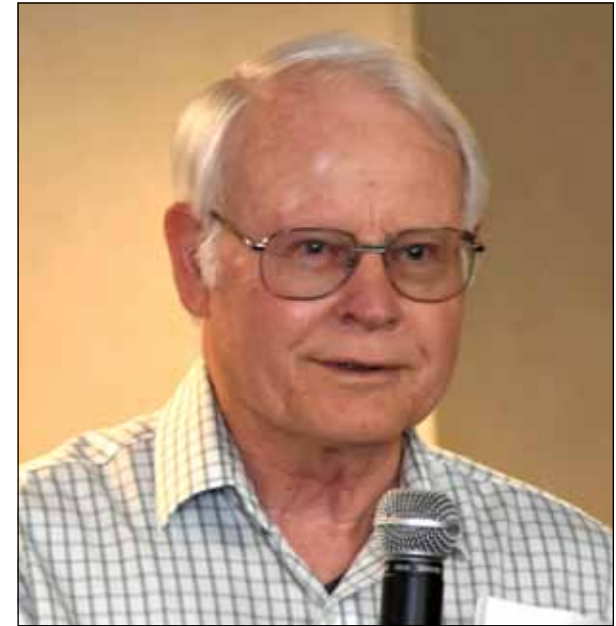
Monthly Board Meeting
