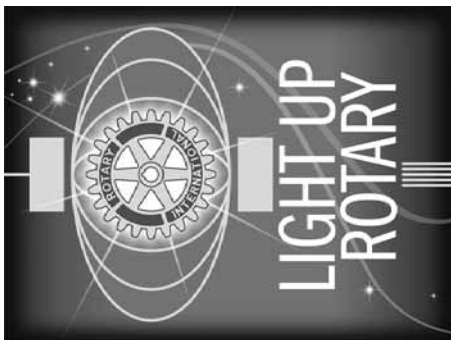

Currently serving as the representative for the 47th District in Carroll, Gallatin, Henry, and Trimble counties, State Representative **Rick Rand** has served the Commonwealth of Kentucky in a variety of capacities since 1991 and continues to do so today. Rep. Rand received his Bachelor of Arts from Hanover College and is employed as an insurance and real estate agent at Rand Insurance and Real Estate. Rep. Rand is a member of the Carroll County and Henry County Chamber of Commerce and the Trimble County Cattleman's Association as well as the Kentucky Biker's Association, the National Rifle Association, and the Independent Insurance Agents of Kentucky. In 1991, Rand was first elected to the General Assembly in the Senate, where he served until 1994, and then was later elected to the House of Representatives in 2003 where he has served ever since. In his legislative capacity, Rep. Rand serves as the chair of the Appropriation and Revenue Committee and the co-chair of the 2016-2018 Budget Preparation



and Submission Committee. He is an ex officio of the Budget Review Subcommittees on Economic Development and Tourism, Natural Resources, and Environmental Protections, the Budget Review Subcommittee on General Government Finance and Public Protection, the Budget Review Subcommittee on Human Resources, the Budget Review Subcommittee on Justice and Judiciary, the Budget Review Subcommittee on Postsecondary Education, the Budget Review Subcommittee on Primary and Secondary Education, and the Budget Review Subcommittee on Transportation. He also serves as a voting member of the Program Review and Investigations Committee.

* Scheduled next Board meeting for April 25, 2016.

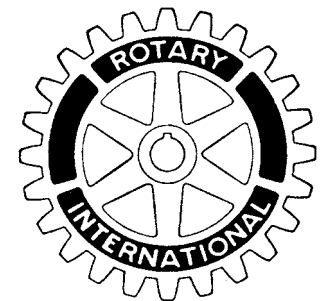
Join Us for the International Dinner!
