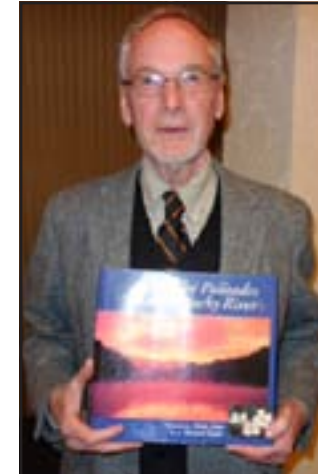

Items donated for the silent auction raised nearly \$1,000 to combat cervical cancer in Haiti.

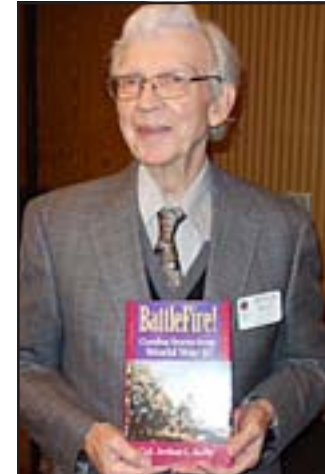
