With a career in law enforcement, Sheriff **Pat Melton**, along with his brother and a cousin, has continued the family tradition started by his father and uncle.



As Franklin County's sheriff, Melton has transformed the Franklin County Sheriff's Office

into a professional and respected law enforcement agency. In the four years he has been Sheriff, he has made the Sheriff's Office a visible entity serving the people of Franklin County. Sheriff Melton was elected to a second term in November 2014. Under his leadership, drug related arrests are up, crime rate is down, the tax collecting function of the office has been improved, and Melton has obtained several millions of dollars in grants for the office.

Melton began his law enforcement career with the FCSO in 1993 as a volunteer deputy. In 2002, Melton accepted a fulltime position with the sheriff's office. This led to Melton being appointed as the first detective within the Franklin County Sheriff's Office in 2003.

In 2005, Melton was selected as one of ten officers statewide to serve on special assignment with the Kentucky State Police Drug Task Force. In 2007, Melton served the Versailles Police Department as a police officer and Public Information Officer. Melton brought these specific abilities and talents to the Sheriff's Office in January 2011.

During his law enforcement career, Melton has served as state coordinator of Project Lifesaver (a program dedicated to locating missing Alzheimer's patients) and created the Kentucky Child Passenger Safety Team. Prior to joining the Sheriff's Department, Melton created and served as Director of the nationally-known "Drive Smart Kentucky" program, served as Director of the Kentucky Public Integrity Unit in the State Auditor's Office and as Assistant Director for Kentucky Disaster and Emergency Services.

Melton will soon celebrate the first anniversary of marriage to his lovely wife, Lindsey. Both Meltons love spending time with his children Patrick (18) and Matthew (15), who play competitive soccer, basketball and football. They are members of the Capital City Christian Church. Melton attended the University of Louisville and received his police office Certification at Eastern Kentucky University.
