Next Week's Program

State Treasurer **Todd Hollenbach** is a native of Jefferson County, where he resides with his wife Rosemarie and their sons Jacob and Reiss. He graduated from the University of Kentucky in 1982 and earned a Law Degree from the University of Louisville in 1985. He was first elected



State Treasurer in 2007 and then re-elected for a second term in 2011. As 'Banker' for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Hollenbach is directly responsible to over four million Kentuckians for the administration of an annual state budget of \$9.5 billion dollars. At the Treasury in Frankfort, he has streamlined internal accounting procedures, modernized office technology, improved customer service, promoted transparency in government and initiated fiscal literacy programs. Under his proactive leadership, Hollenbach also created the *Treasure Finders* initiative, a no-cost program he takes directly to the counties to find the rightful owners of millions of dollars in unclaimed or abandoned property. He has set

a goal of visiting all 120 counties and returning to Kentucky citizens \$100 million dollars before the end of his term. So far he has held *Treasure Finder* events in more than half the counties and returned a record \$80 million.

As a Commissioner with the Kentucky Commission on Human Rights, he worked diligently to insure that the rights of all Kentuckians were protected regardless of race, religion, age or gender. His reputation for fair dealing and hard work also earned him a position on the bi-partisan Blue Ribbon Commission convened to investigate the state merit hiring system. As Vice-Chair of the State Investment Commission, Hollenbach monitors Kentucky's investment of more than \$3 billion to assure that state government and its taxpayers receive the highest possible return.

As a member of the Kentucky Lottery Board, Hollenbach has worked to ensure that the revenues generated by the lottery are sufficient to fund the Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship (KEES), a program that rewards graduating high school seniors with scholarships for Kentucky colleges. Most recently, Hollenbach successfully spearheaded a program to substantially increase lottery revenues for education through expanded gaming.
