

Stuart Alexander was born in Heidelberg,



Germany and was raised in Louisville. He obtained his undergraduate degree from St. John's University and his J.D. from the University of Louisville. He is also Senior Professional Human Resource (SPHR) certified, which assists him in his Louisville law prac-

tice, focusing on employment and business law. Stuart has served on the boards of Sister Cities of Louisville, the Kentucky Shakespeare Festival, and the Americana Community Center, which provides services for the US Department of State's refugee resettlement program.

Stuart joined the Rotary Club of Louisville in 1994 and became active on the International Service Committee. He has participated in several international projects including microlending in Belize, water/sanitation projects in Uganda, and Ghana, and cervical cancer screening in Haiti.
