Kentucky Book Fair vice-president **Ellen Hellard** has been a member of the board of the Fair since its inception 34 years ago.



She initially represented the Kentucky Department for Libraries and Archives, where she worked for 28 years. Her job with the KDLA was in public library development, first as a regional librarian and then as Director of the Division of Field Services.

After retiring from KDLA, she became manager of the Kentucky Book Fair for eight years. She also was a researcher for the UK Basketball Museum. She serves on the board of Studio Players, a 64-year-old community theatre in Lexington, and has produced and acted in several plays. She also serves as a consultant to the Kentucky Humanities Council Chautauqua program.

Ellen lives in Versailles and is the widow of Vic Hellard, Jr., former Director of the Legislative Research Commission.
