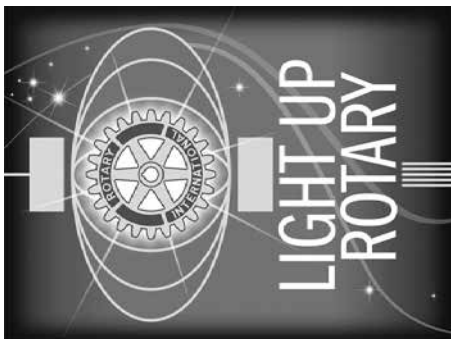

Rick Rogers, elected to the post of Franklin County Jailer in January 2015, graduated from Franklin County High School in 1994 and attended Eastern Kentucky University from 1994-97, with a major in Criminal Justice. He joined the Marines reserves in December 1997 and became a Military Policeman. Rick was activated for Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003. He is a combat veteran with numerous awards and received an honorable discharge in 2005 at the rank of Corporal.

Rick was hired at the Franklin County Regional Jail in May 1999 and promoted up the chain of command until he was hired in October 2007 at the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. In March 2008 he graduated an 18-week academy course with the Department of Criminal Justice. He is a founding member of the SWAT team, a member of the Mounted Patrol Unit and was promoted to Detective in April 2013.
