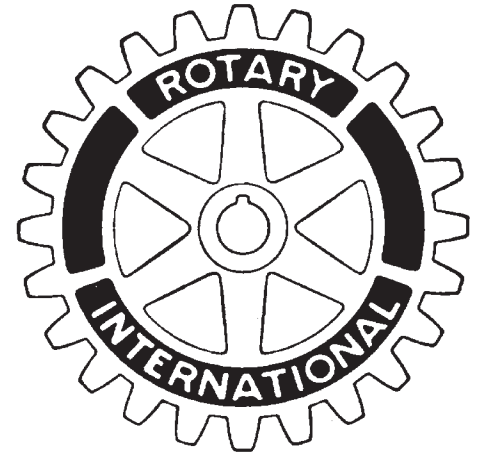
- Demonstrating a high standard of ethical business practices toward their customers and their employees;
