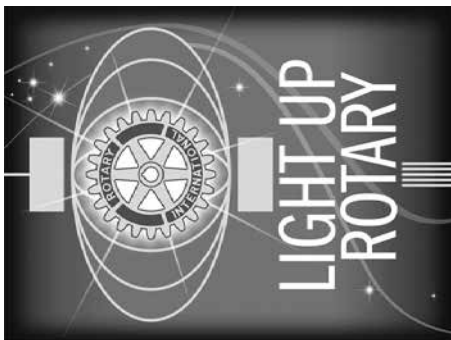

Frankfort Fire Chief **Eddie Slone** will be discussing Automatic Aid as it relates to Frankfort and Franklin County. An Automatic Aid Agreement between two or more Fire Departments results in the seamless dispatching of the nearest trained firefighters and equipment within an agreed upon area in order to more efficiently save lives and property. The practice requires cooperation, common practices and training in order to be effective.

The City of Frankfort and Franklin County governments continue to work on a mutually beneficial agreement that will improve the efficiency of both fire departments without unduly leaving an area within either jurisdiction susceptible to any type of loss.

Eddie Slone began his career with the Frankfort Fire Department in 1994 as a firefighter and paramedic. He promoted through the ranks of the department and was appointed Chief in 2013.
