## 2018 District Conference

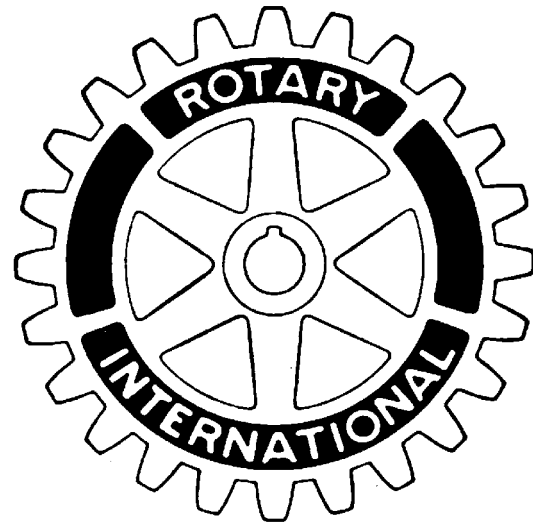

**Jennifer Adrio** is the Regional Chief Executive Officer for the Kentucky Region of the American Red Cross. Adrio began her non-profit career with the Red Cross over 28 years ago and rejoined the Red Cross as the Kentuckiana CEO in September of 2013. She previously worked at Metro United Way for 23 years, serving as the Executive Vice President from 2000 to 2013, where she led and grew a \$30 million dollar fundraising department. During her tenure at United Way, the organization received several national awards for initiatives in increasing revenues in planned giving and major gift programs.

During a restructure at the American Red Cross, Jennifer was named the Regional CEO for the entire state of Kentucky and part of southern Indiana. Under Jennifer's dynamic leadership, the Red Cross Kentucky Region has risen to one of the most respected and top producing of the 60 regions nationally. Jennifer was recently selected to serve as the interim

CEO for the South Florida Region to help lead them during a transitional period.

Jennifer was born in Hannibal, MO and grew up in the Midwest. She has a B.B.A. in Marketing from the University of Iowa. She is an experienced leader and is well regarded for her fundraising ability throughout the region. She resides in Louisville with her youngest son Cole, a junior at Western Kentucky University.
