Jeri Katherine Howell is an Americana singer-songwriter-guitarist, teaching artist and creative placemaker from Frankfort. Her mission is to help foster more socially and environmentally sustainable communities through non-formal arts and environmental education and creative community experiences. She does this work through Frankfort's Josephine Sculpture Park (where she is Program Coordinator), Joanna Hay Productions and Hands Healing HeArts. Jeri Katherine also seeks to build cultural exchange by offering bilingual songwriting and flat-foot dance workshops, and pursuing experiences such as a Kentucky Bluegrass Week tour in Yamaguchi, Japan (2016) and a Fulbright grant to Costa Rica through the U.S. Department of State (2017). In 2018, Jeri Katherine received the Kentucky Foundation for Women Firestarter award for her work as a feminist social change

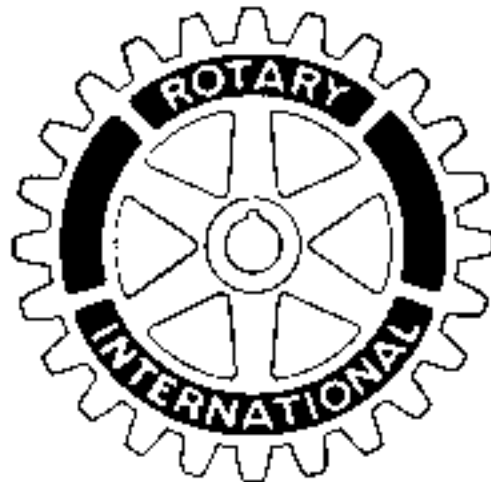
