Reporter Jack Brammer, who has covered nine governors and some of the state's biggest stories in a 40-year career at the Lexington Herald-Leader, will be inducted into the Kentucky Journalism Hall of Fame this year. Brammer, 67, is the newspaper's Frankfort bureau chief.

He is one of six people to be inducted into the hall of fame in the School of Journalism and Media at the University of Kentucky. The hall of fame recognizes Kentuckians who have made significant contributions to journalism. Nominees must be natives of Kentucky or journalists who have spent a significant portion of their careers in Kentucky.

Brammer, a native of Maysville who has a masters in communication from UK, worked at the Sentinel-News in Shelbyville for two years before joining the Lexington Leader in 1978. He has covered state government since.
