**Kentucky River Cruise**

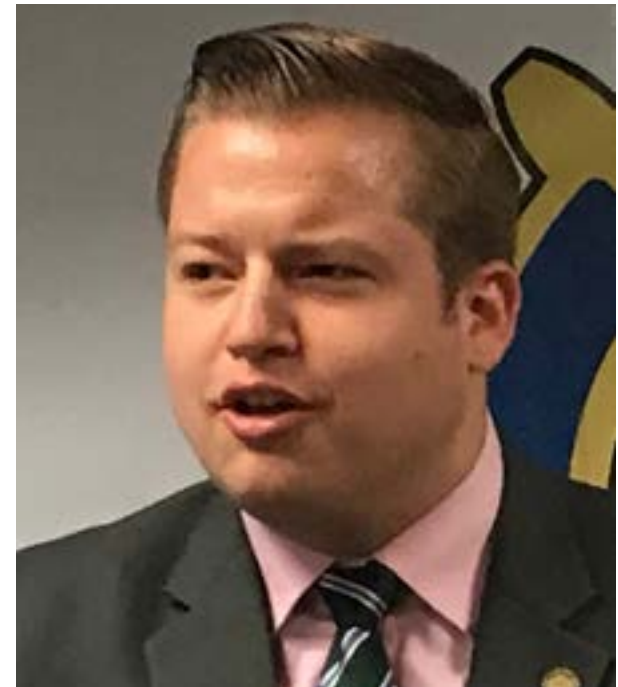
