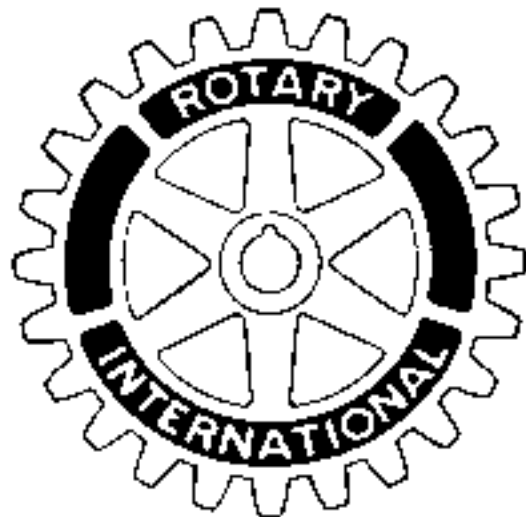

Wendy Kobler is vice president of Institutional Advancement at Kentucky State University and a fellow Rotarian. Throughout her career in higher education, she has turned around underperforming advancement divisions at four universities. Championing her personal philosophy of perpetually building, her work has always been done with one eye focused on creating present day outcomes, and the other eye focused on building a lasting model for the future. By generating impactful fundraising campaigns, prospect solicitation messages, and donor relationship strategies, she is consistently able to establish new fundraising records and many "firsts." This success is sustained and strengthened by building the brand, the team, development processes, and best-in-class cultivation practices.

Within its first six months at KSU, her team increased fundraising 250% over the previous year. She is adapt at process improvement and has worked to implement the first Gift Acceptance

Policy, which was unanimously approved by the Board of Regents at their December meeting. As the former Vice President for Advancement at Wittenberg University, Wendy transformed the Advancement division and delivered the best fundraising results in more than five years.

Wendy just completed her PhD in Global Leadership from Indiana Institute of Technology, and wrote her dissertation about the pathway to the CEO position for women in higher education. Her M.S. from Alabama A&M University has a marketing and education focus.

Wendy began at KSU in July and is thrilled to be part of the proud Thoroughbred community. She loves living in downtown Frankfort.
