- Approved the minutes of the January 9, 2019 board minutes. Bill Miller made the motion, second by Kristin Cantrell.

- Approved Leave-of-Absence for Ed Dance from 2/1/19 to 3/31/19. Alex Fitzgerald made the motion, second by John Avent.
