- Approved the minutes of the 2/20/19 board meeting. Fred Deaton made the motion, second by Kristin Cantrell.

- Listened to Financial Report for February 2019 as presented by John Avent.

- Membership Development Director Diane Dehoney reported that the club has 83 Active members and 3 Honorary members.

- International Service Director Bill Miller reported that Rotary is on track with this year's UN Day which will be in New York on 11/9/19.

He also reported that the Rotary International Dinner speaker will be Eric Gregory with the Kentucky Distillers Association and will speak on bourbon in Kentucky. There will also be a Silent Auction at the dinner; Teresa Hockensmith and Brenda Rice are working on collecting donated items for the auction.

- President Alex reported that Chris Boni is working on the Rotary Scholarship program.

- Grant Program Chair Gordon Saks reported that he has met with the new Frankfort City Parks Manager concerning the moving of the Gazebo at the Legacy Park. Gordon said the Parks Department will move the Gazebo to its correct place.

- Public Relations Director Steve Stewart acknowledged the new club directory is ready and was available at this week's meeting. Steve also reported that he was paying the print bill for the club.

- Approved the payment of \$100 to be paid to Steve Fry for his work on the club directory. Alex Fitzgerald made the motion, second by Fred Deaton.
