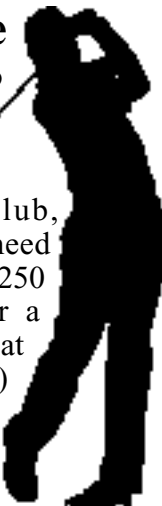
KSU Weekly Club Meeting
