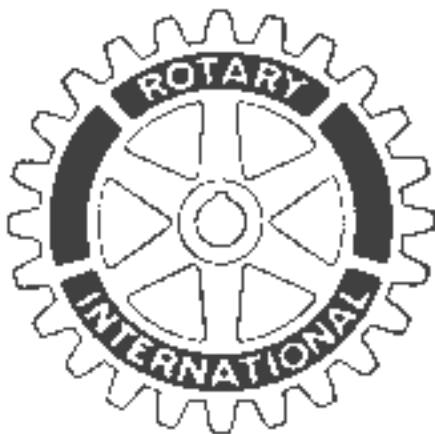
- President Alex discussed request from Vocational Service Director Carmen Inman on her request for club participation on a Chamber project. No action taken until further information can be given to the board.
